This is done through the Case Management methodology and enhancement of local community alternatives.






★Cash Transfer Program (CTP):

★ The Elderly:

The number of expected persons receiving shelter services in 2023 in the Beit Al Ajdad Center is 120 lodgers at an estimated monthly cost for each lodger at ILS2,500. The expected number of elderly beneficiaries from day programs, social and psychological activities and life skills at the Beit Al Ajdad Center in 2023 is 300, at an estimated monthly cost of ILS300 per elderly person.
