Highlight of Programs and Services Provided to Beneficiaries

- The number of children who will receive protection and care services in 2017 is 3,859 children
- Periodic orphans sponsorship, assistance to 5,000 orphans in the amount of USD 2,339,057
- Sponsorship for 300 deprived families in the amount of USD 297,325
- Free health insurance will be provided to 120,000 families in 2017
- Provide ration cards for poor families and regular food assistance to 216,000 individual

Women and gender unit: Provide support, social guidance, empowerment and protection to women victims of gender-based violence and their children, reintegrate them into society with dignity and mainstream gender issues in the ministry's programs and plans


